This is an excellent opportunity to learn about the Cultural Resource Management business and expand skillsets through hands-on activities. The available position is full-time (40 hours per week) and will last a minimum of six months.

Tasks associated with this level of responsibility include:

- Reconnaissance and intensive architectural surveys
- Archival and historical research
- Preparation of historic contexts
- Report production
- Compilation of architectural resource packets according to state guidelines

Minimum qualifications and critical competencies:

- Bachelor's degree in architectural history, art history, historic preservation, history, or a closely related field preferred
- At least four months of related experience in a cultural resource management, academic, or similar setting
- Basic understanding of the common architectural styles and elements found in Dovetail's service area
- Basic understanding of the National Register of Historic Places Criteria for Evaluation and Aspects of Integrity
- Working knowledge of the Microsoft Office Suite
- Ability to work outdoors in hot or cold temperatures, in conditions that may include wind, rain, and/or snow
- Ability to travel overnight
