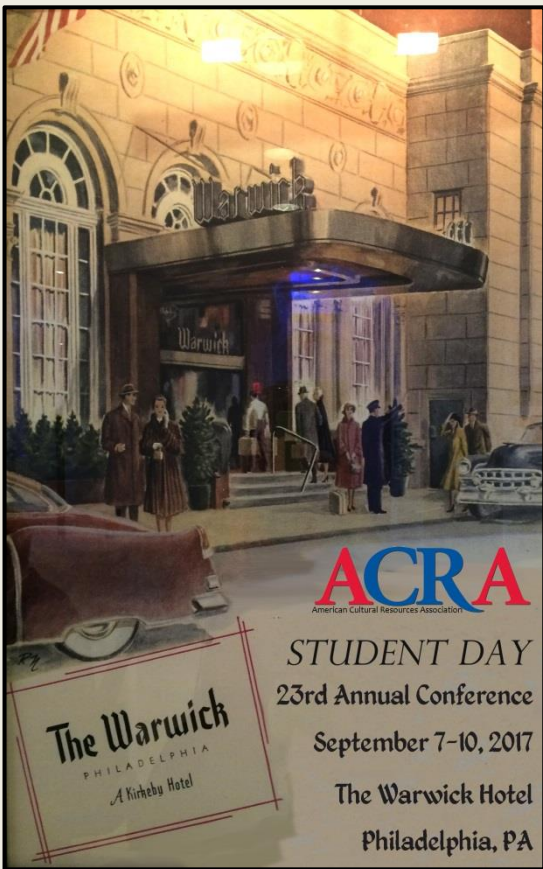


ACRA TO HOST A **STUDENT DAY** AT ITS 23RD ANNUAL CONFERENCE!
